- I. Call to Order 7:12pm

- III. Director's Report – Katherine Green
 - A. Choir status at this point 105 students in all choirs: 36 Show Choir, 39 Concert Choir, 23 Treble Choir, 16 Mixed Choir
 - B. Robed Choirs – Treble Choir: will be establishing leadership soon.
 - C. Focus on community and gratitude. Will be producing a fall show.
- IV. Message from Student Leadership
 - A. Darby, Concert Choir – everyone is participating, and it is going well. Student teacher, Justin Trujillo.
 - B. Taylor, Show Choir – we have started projects. Disney characters were assigned in the summer meet ups. We are establishing a routine: 15 jumping jacks, squats, sit ups and push-ups for a 30 day challenge.

- VI. Tentative Schedule for the year
 - A. Plan is for a virtual concert for the fall. Susia's brother, Matt, may be available to help with the platform for a concert. It would be a paid position. If he is not available, there is digital technology we can use but is very time consuming. All plans are TBD.
